Admission requirements:

- · Currently working in childcare
- Associate degree or equivalent academic experience
- Meet basic competencies for reading, writing, and math by:
 - 1) passing ACT or SAT scores
 - 2) Basic competency courses with a B or higher
 - 3) passing Praxis I scores

Program details:

- Take 39 ECE core credits at URI, transfer credits from other accredited schools, and accumulate 120 credits to earn a bachelor's degree and then apply for Pre-K-2 teacher certification.
- One online course per 7-week session, 9 sessions in 2 years
