Basic Competency Requirements

All undergraduates are required, to provide evidence of meeting the RI Department of Education's basic competency requirements for admission. There are multiple ways that students may meet these requirements:

1. **Complete basic competency courses offered through URI in Math, Reading, and Writing (EDC: 280,281,282) with a B or higher:**
