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## Semester Course Descriptions

### **Advocacy 101 for ECE Leaders**

In this one-session offering, participants will learn about becoming an advocate for themselves, their students, and early childhood education.

### **A Common Goal: Fostering Empathetic Relationships Within a Child's Care Team**

This series presented by the Autism Project will explore how to build trusting and effective relationships with a child's care team. Both the family and professional perspectives are brought into this course.

### **An Introduction to Autism and Self-Regulation**

This series provides an overview of Autism with a focus on practices to support children with ASD and self-regulation.

### **Beyond Colors, Shapes, and Numbers: Planning and Implementing Appropriate Curriculum for Toddlers**

This series will support teachers in creating high-quality learning experiences for young toddlers and two-year-olds.

### **Brain Power: 4 Part Series in Social Emotional Learning (previously called Our Amazing Brain)**

This series focuses on the brain development and learning, including the concepts of Conscious Discipline's Brain State Model.

### **Conscious Coaching: Supporting Staff Well-Being**

This training is designed to guide administrators in how to use the powers and skills of Conscious Discipline to better support staff well-being and professionalism.

### **Creating an Employee Handbook and Creating a Family Handbook**

This mini-series will walk through what employee and family handbooks are, offer tips on how to write them, and provide guidance on what key components to include.

### **Developing a Standard of Care for your Outdoor Space**

LISC and its Rhode Island Child Care and Early Learning Facilities Fund will provide a brief overview on the important role that childcare facilities, particularly outdoor space, play in overall program quality.

### **Effective Classroom Practices for the First Six Weeks of School**

This series will support preschool teachers as they plan for the first six weeks of the school year and learn a variety of strategies for supporting students' social-emotional development.

### **Extending Children's Learning Through Creative Arts**

This series is designed to help beginning teachers, teacher assistants, and family child care educators understand how learning through creative arts can be enhanced by interactions with others.

### **Engaging Infants and Toddlers in STEAM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts, and Math)**

This series provides an overview of the components of STEAM, along with ways to incorporate STEAM into the curriculum and everyday activities with the infants and toddlers in your care.

### **Family Engagement: Culturally Responsive Approach**

Strategies for building strong relationships with families and engaging them in their children's development and learning are addressed in this course.

### **Inclusive Practices for Children and Families**

This series will support educators to engage and include ALL children, including children with disabilities and challenging behaviors in their classrooms and family childcare settings.

### **It All Begins with Play!**

Content in this series will explore the benefits of play for all children including those with neurodevelopmental disabilities, on the Autism Spectrum, and impacted by trauma and chronic stress.

### **Learning about Self, Family, Classroom, and Community: An Overview of the Social Studies RIELDS**

This series will unpack the new Social Studies RIELDS and explore how to implement best practices to support learning about self, family, classroom, and community.

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**Practical Approaches to Behavior for All Children**

Each session in this 4-part series will focus on a specific instructional practice that aims to support children's social-emotional development and engagement in the classroom community.

**PreK to K Transition**

This one-session PD opportunity will support administrators and PreK teachers in understanding their role in supporting children and families during the transition to Kindergarten.

**Exploring Identity, Implicit Bias, and Anti-bias Education through Reflective Practice**

In this in-depth series, participants will examine identify, implicit bias, and the components of an anti-bias curriculum.

**Reflective Practice: Introduction to Implicit Bias in the EC Classroom**

In this introductory session, we will examine exactly what is Implicit Bias and look at why it matters in our early childhood classrooms.

**Science Talk and Inquiry: An Overview of Best Science Practices**

This multi-session series will provide participants with an overview of the new Science RIELDS, the inquiry cycle, and the importance of using science talk in the classroom.

**Strengthening Business Practices: A Series for Administrators**

This series will support administrators in developing and/or strengthening their foundational knowledge of business practices. Sessions will cover topics including finance, marketing, and human resource management.

**Strengthening Business Practices: Recruiting, Hiring, and Retaining Staff**

This series will support administrators in the innovation of the management components needed to address current staffing challenges in the early care and education community.

**Supporting Social and Emotional Development: The Preschool Years**

This series provides a comprehensive overview of social and emotional development in preschool-aged children.

**Two is Not the New Five: Understanding Infant and Toddler Development**

This series provides an overview of the physical, social and emotional, cognitive, and language development of children from birth to age 3.

**Using ECERS-3 to Improve Classroom and Program Quality**

This series provides an overview of the Early Childhood Environment Rating Scale (ECERS) 3 for directors, education coordinators, and classroom teachers so that they can use the tool to assess quality in preschool classrooms.

**Using ITERS-3 to Improve Classroom and Program Quality**

This series provides an overview of the Infant-Toddler Environment Rating Scale (ITERS) 3 for directors, education coordinators, and classroom teachers so that they can use the tool to assess quality in infant and toddler classrooms.

**Using the CLASS PreK or Infant/Toddler to Improve Classroom and Program Practices**

This series provides an overview of the Classroom Assessment Scoring System (CLASS) PreK or for Infant/Toddler for directors, education coordinators, and classroom teachers so that they can use the tool to assess quality in classrooms.

**What is Infant Mental Health?**

This 2-part series is an introduction to the field of Infant Mental Health that will define Infant Mental Health, explore its influence on social and emotional development in the early years and highlight effective provider practice.

**What You Say Matters: Strengthening Interactions Throughout the Day**

This Level 1 series provides new teachers, teacher assistants and family childcare educators with a look at the importance of positive relationships and interactions to children's development and learning.

**Young Scientist Series: Exploring Balls and Ramps**

This series is designed to build teachers' capacity to use an inquiry-based approach to science in the preschool setting. The sessions emphasize planning, facilitation, and reflection as key teaching strategies for maximizing children's science learning.

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
